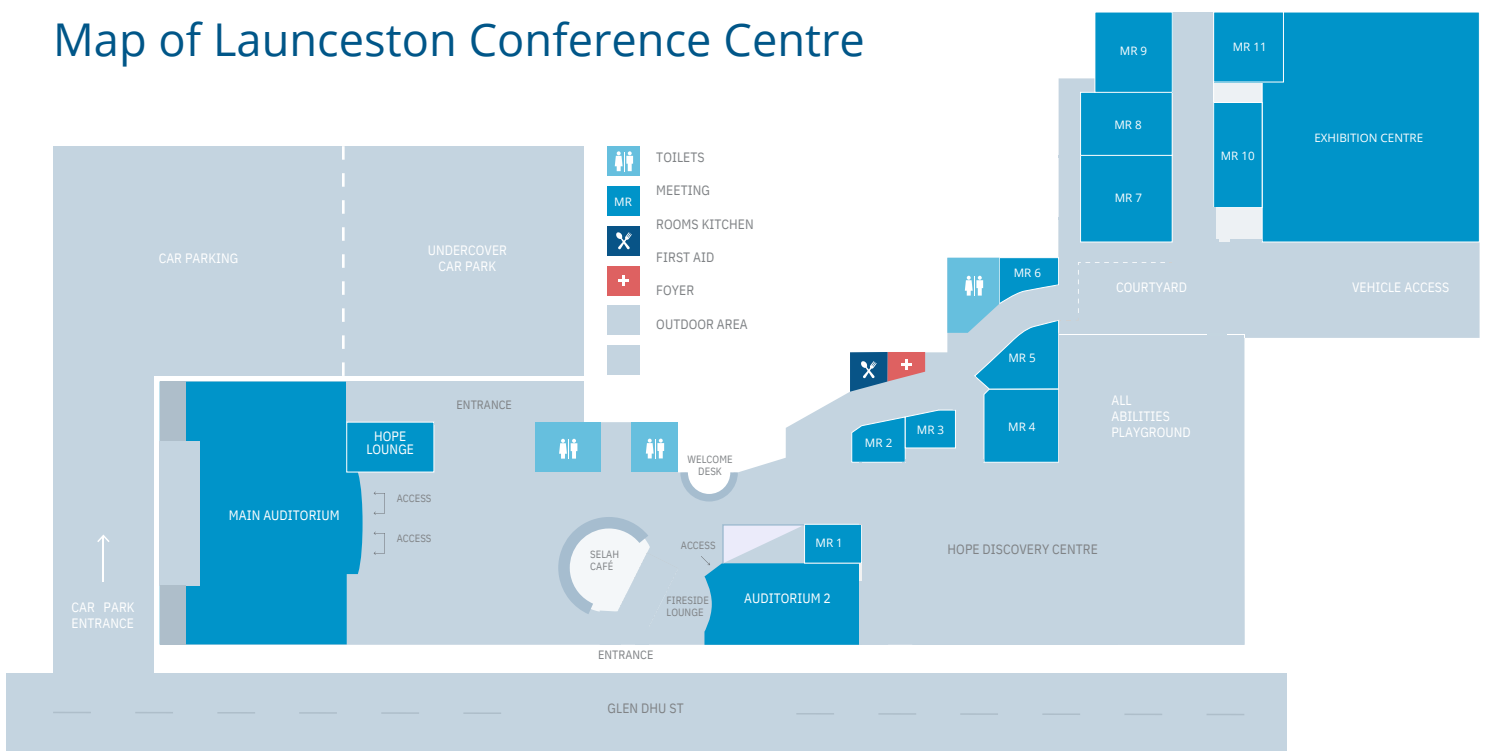
**Registration:** Registration, morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea will be located in the foyer outside main auditorium entrance.
